- 3. Children who live closest to the school measured by the nearest available walking route.




















## **School Rules**

- School rules provide guidelines for acceptable pupil behavior and conduct. Every pupil is expected to be familiar and comply with these stipulated rules.
   General Rules for Parents/Guardians
  - 1. Parents / Guardians must essentially be co-operative with the school management and the staff members in maintaining the discipline and decorum of the School.
  - 2. Parents / Guardians should enforce regularity and punctuality with regard to their child's attendance.
  - 3. Parents / Guardians must send their child to the school neatly dressed in the prescribed uniform.
  - 4. School timings are from 8:45 am to 12:30 pm. Latecomers will not be permitted inside.
  - 5. Parents / Guardians should help the child to prepare for their lessons at home.
  - 6. Parents / Guardians are welcome between 10:00 am to 11:00 am to take the feedback with regard to their child's performance.
  - 7. Parents / Guardians are not allowed to visit the classes or meet the teachers during school hours without the permission of the principal.
  - 8. Parents / Guardians must compulsorily attend the parent-teacher interactive sessions to be consistently updated about their child's performance.
  - 9. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any valuable belongings carried by the students.
  - 10. Parents must send their children to an authorized person only for pick-up and drop.
  - 11. The parents should notify the class in charge about the reason of leave in case of the long absence of their child.

## Our Curriculum

## An Outline of the subjects offered

### **English**

Literacy and English skills are absolutely essential for every pupil as without that knowledge, children are not able to progress in other areas of the curriculum. Starting in Nursery, children are taught how to use books, to enjoy a story read to them and to 'read' their own stories. In stage 1, the school also follows the Letters and Sounds Phonics the programme which supports them as they learn to read and spell. In stage 2, the pupil's literacy skills are further developed so that by the end of year 6 all children have reached the level where they are prepared for the increasing demands of secondary school.

### **Mathematics**

It is vital that children are able to use mathematical skills so that they can take a full part in everyday life. At Enaraa we understand how important it is that children can perform well in maths. Beginning at the very early stages, children are introduced to practical activities, dealing with situations that occur in everyday life. All pupils have daily maths lessons where numeracy skills are systematically taught and where pupils are shown how to apply these skills to solve problems. The math lab is used effectively to introduce key practical concepts.

## Science

Science is developed through practical experiences relating to everyday situations. Beginning in the Nursery, children are encouraged to explore and talk about their activities, to look carefully at objects and the world around them and to use equipment correctly. You can help your child by talking to them about everyday things, for example, at bath time playing with water, visiting the park, investigating toys which move, caring for plants and animals and discussing the dangers of electricity.

## **Computing & Art**

Children are encouraged to use the computer in all curriculum areas as another way of working. They are taught to store and print their own work. Pupils are taught how to use the Internet safely and critically. Throughout the school, children are given wide-ranging opportunities to work with different materials, drawing, painting, printmaking and making models etc.

## **Physical Education**

Each week the children participate in indoor and outdoor PE lessons and are encouraged to develop basic skills in games and martial arts.
